WHO WE ARE?

No Name Kitchen (NNK) is a grassroots civil movement to defend the rights of people on the move and asylum seekers. We confront systemic violence while providing essential support, including food, health care, clothing, emergency rescues, and legal assistance for the dignity and safety of those forced to flee.

We operate on the ground with field teams working 24/7 in critical border zones across the Balkans, Mediterranean, and Maghreb migration routes. But we don't just respond to crises—we aim to provoke sociopolitical change by addressing the root causes of border abuses. Since 2017, NNK has documented over 12,000 cases of border violence, contributing to advocacy processes at national and European parliaments and playing a key role in critical resolutions in [Italy](#), [Spain](#), [Bulgaria](#) and the [ECHR](#).

WHAT WE DO?

- 1. HEALTH ON THE MOVE** providing hygiene kits, showers, anti-scabies packs, laundry, dental & eye care, and psycho-emotional support—promoting health, dignity, and resilience.
- 2. AID DISTRIBUTIONS** delivering food, clothing, blankets, and vouchers, **tailored to real needs**, while offering **solidarity and care**.
- 3. SEARCH & RESCUE** of lost or injured people, including families and minors, providing **life-saving support** and alerting authorities.
- 4. VIOLENCE MONITORING & LEGAL PROTECTION** documenting border violence, collect testimonies, produce advocacy reports, and pursue **strategic litigation** to protect rights.
